

## Service-Learning Ambassador Program

This is an extra module exclusively for educators who would like to join with GNGP Schools to share their students' work with the world.

GNGP Schools has a public website, as well as other digital media platforms (social media, fundraising pages), which are specifically to celebrate and showcase the Service-Learning projects students have designed and implemented.

Educators decide before they start the core GNGP Schools curriculum, if they will commit to the Ambassador extra module. This is necessary to begin the process of getting permissions for students to be included in publicly posted media (see next point).

GNGP Schools will provide Media Releases to teachers. These releases are to be signed by parents or legal guardians of <u>every</u> student in the GNGP Schools program who will be <u>included</u> in photographs and other media, *all of which may be publicly shared on the internet and other publications*.

Full names on Media Releases are required for *all persons* in any media provided to GNGP Schools. GNGP will never use the last names of participants in public posts. Participants' last names should not be visible on any projects.

Educators must inform GNGP Schools of any unwilling participants shown in digital or other media so we may 'blur out' their identities when said media is uploaded, preferably before.

GNGP Schools will provide individual DropBox folders to each educator at the start of the Ambassador module for all digital media to be uploaded.

We encourage educators to start at the beginning by documenting with photographs, as much of the module processes as possible throughout the program. This is in addition to uploading final student projects and all work associated with the main Service-Learning Project process.

All Ambassador module program projects as well as signed Model Releases, along with lists of persons portrayed in all media, must be submitted within 30 days of completion of the students' final Service-Learning Projects.

GNGP Schools will pay each educator, per license, \$595 for accurate and timely participation in this optional, additional, post-program submission.
